Isaiah 64:8

⁸ Yet you, LORD, are our Father. We are the clay, you are the potter; we are all the work of your hand.

Romans 9:20-22

²⁰ But who are you, a human being, to talk back to God? "Shall what is formed say to the one who formed it, 'Why did you make me like this?'" ²¹ Does not the potter have the right to make out of the same lump of clay some pottery for special purposes and some for common use?

What are some of the things that makes our heart hard and causes us not to hear God?

- What are some Bible stories about people who had to wait on God that can inspire you as you wait?
- What will you do to develop patience while waiting on God this week?
